The Camp

Kalepo is a private, owner-run, luxury tented camp in the heart of Samburuland, Northern Kenya. It sits on 450,000 acres of unfenced wilderness straddling both sides of the Mathews Mountains, exclusive use, entirely yours, for the duration of your stay. This is Kenya's Big North: remote, raw, and unlike anywhere else on the continent.

Facilities

Six guest tents set along a dry river in the shade of ancient acacias. A plunge pool and a spa. A gym, a boutique shop, and a wildlife hide overlooking its own dedicated waterhole. A second waterhole draws wildlife to a different part of camp. An organic herb and vegetable garden and a sustainable tilapia fish farm mean much of what arrives at the table was growing that morning.

Accommodation

All six tents are en-suite, solar-powered, and open to the elements in the ways that matter. Outdoor bathrooms with flushing toilets, hot showers and double basins. King or twin configuration. Overhead fans. Daily laundry. Exercise baskets with yoga mats and resistance bands in each tent. No mini bars, but cold drinks are never far away.

Four standard tents (Tents 1, 2, 3 and 6) sleep up to 8 adults comfortably. The family unit (Tents 4 and 5) consists of two adjacent tents that connect easily, sleeping up to 4 adults or children with extra beds available on request. The camp accommodates up to 18 guests, with two additional guide tents for nannies, pilots, private guides or group chaperones. Larger groups can be accommodated on special request.

Starlink keeps you connected in the main areas of camp. The tents are intentionally offline, which, once you are here, feels entirely right.

Food & Beverage

Family-style dining, made with fresh produce from the garden and tailored to every dietary requirement. Meals move between locations depending on the time of day and the mood of the group. A well-stocked bar with a serious selection of wines and high-end spirits. Nothing here is rushed.

For Families

Kalepo welcomes children of all ages. Cots, high-chairs and basic child-minding facilities are all available. The camp and its guides are experienced with families and genuinely enjoy having children in camp.

Access

Kalepo has its own private airstrip, a 20-minute drive from camp. There are no scheduled flights. All guests arrive by private charter and our team will coordinate everything once your dates are confirmed.

Activities

Activities at Kalepo are guided by Daniel and Mrefu, two Samburu guides whose knowledge of this landscape and the people who live in it is without parallel.

Standard activities included in your stay:

- Bush walks and treks with Samburu guides
- Samburu homestead visits
- Samburu blacksmith visits
- Samburu warrior games
- Mountain bike rides
- Local school and clinic visits
- Women's agricultural project visit

Health & Malaria

Kalepo is in a low-risk malaria area. Insect repellent is provided in all tents. Guests are advised to consult their doctor about malaria prophylaxis before travelling.

Accessibiliy

Kalepo is not designed for wheelchair access, though guests in wheelchairs have visited before. Please contact us directly and we will give you an honest picture of what is and is not possible.

Tipping

Gratuities are entirely at your discretion and are shared among the full Kalepo team, a dedicated group of 50, most of them Samburu, who make every stay what it is. As a guide: USD 25 to USD 50 per guest per night for general camp staff, and USD 20 per guide per day. Daniel and Mrefu are the best in the business.
